- 1) **Various volunteering activities** (Volunteering activities beyond the language barrier): offline activities, Irregular volunteering activities unrelated to Korean language ability (Plogging while visiting cultural heritage, delivering kimchi/briquettes, etc.)

- 2) **Mother tongue education program** (seeking my mother tongue identity for communication at home): Online activities, From November to January, once a week, beginner-level Thai/Russian education for teenagers with multicultural(migration) backgrounds by teams for each language. A. Necessary

- SNU members(Any student/professor/employee, including students on leave, exchange, international students, and graduate students) who are able to participate throughout the program
- A person who can actively participate throughout the program with a passion for volunteer work
- A person who has a passion for more social contribution and volunteer work after the program
- Participants from previous semesters can also apply
- A person who would actively prepare and participate in regular planning meetings and volunteering activities
- A person who can actively participate in usual discussions and communication

※ Orientation and farewell activity are required to participate

B. Preferential Conditions

- Mother tongue education program: A person who has experienced **teaching a language(Thai, Russian)** that youth participants with multicultural(migration) background want to learn(Communication skills are required).
- A person who can only speak Korean and English, but faithfully participate in volunteer work

2. Examples of various volunteering activities

• Plogging	• Example: plogging for environmental beautification activities while incorporating natural or cultural heritage tours (in parallel with history/culture study)
• Campaign	• Example: Campaign on topics related to the coexistence of various cultures, such as cultural diversity and global citizens
• Making and delivering Kimchi	• Example: Making and delivering kimchi for neighbors who are experiencing financial hardship or older adults living alone
• Delivering coal briquettes	• Example: Delivery of briquettes for neighbors who are experiencing difficulties in winter
• Supporting Older adults living alone	• Example: Home visit cleaning for older adults living alone, lunch deliveries, etc.
• Protecting children	• Example: Support for road safety on the road and distribution of road safety children's books
• Prevention of COVID-19 infection	• Example: Campaign to encourage wearing of masks in cooperation with local ward offices such as Itaewon, Hongdae, and Seoul National University Station
• etc	• Irregular(one-time) volunteering activities planned by volunteers through regular planning meetings

Option 2**Main activities: Mother tongue education program**

☞ From 2021.11 to 2022.01, once a week, SNU members and youth participants with multicultural(migration) backgrounds form teams by a language, and they will plan, prepare and conduct education programs to teach and learn the language that the youth wish to learn(**Thai, Russian**)

1. Method

- Every Tuesday 19:00, program planning meeting (only volunteers)
- Once a week, through online video conference system (Zoom), mother tongue education activities (with youth participants)
- Ice breaking and orientation using online video conferencing system (Zoom)
- Kakao Talk open chat room will be operated by each language team
- 2022.01.21.(Fri)~23.(Sun), preparation and conduct of global cultural diversity camp and Farewell activity

2. Examples of Native Language Education Activities

• Chorus of trendy local language songs	• Homework: Practice singing to prepare for chorus
• Talking while watching the latest trend on YouTube	• Homework: Watching YouTube videos
• My parents' childhood story	• Homework: Interviewing my parents
• A day in 000 country	• Homework: Write down my day in Korea and compare it with the days of adolescence in the country where the volunteers lived
• 000 country online travel	• Homework: Search for destinations in 000 country and write down why you want to go there
• Mother tongue education (conversation, grammar, vocabulary, reading comprehension, etc.)	• Homework: Weekly homework
• Presentation in mother tongue	• Homework: Prepare a presentation in mother tongue (may be made with your mother tongue class)
• Oral fairy tales in mother tongue	• Homework: Find a word you don't know from a fairy tale or ask a question through an open chat room
• Various other methods of enjoyable mother tongue (including culture) education	
• Preparation for global cultural diversity camp (preparation for foreign culture experience booth, culture night preparation)	

☞ From 2022.01.21.(Fri) to 2022.01.23.(Sun), SNU volunteers with various backgrounds and local community members with migration background are invited to Seoul National University to hold a global cultural diversity camp for 3 days and 2 nights (Accommodation will not be provided to volunteers)

1. Methods

- Volunteers return home at 21:00 (accommodation not provided)
- To prevent the spread of COVID-19, meals are provided in individually edible packed lunches or school meals.
- Active camp preparation and participation of volunteers is essential
- Every Tuesday 19:00 Program planning meeting (only volunteers)
